

Baku hosts Azerbaijan-Romania business forum (газета (на английском языке) –azernews)

An Azerbaijan-Romania business forum was held in Baku on Thursday. Minister for economic development Farhad Aliyev told the event that its key goal is to establish economic relations between the two countries' businessmen and look into the opportunities of accelerating the inflow of investments in Azerbaijan.

Aliyev said Romania will play a great role in taking Azerbaijani products to European markets in the future and assist in expanding the country's leasing, insurance and banking sectors.

Mechanical engineering, transport, construction, oil, food, textile, and furniture production were a focus of discussions during the forum, attended by over 70 Azeri businessmen and representatives of 12 Romanian companies.
